STIPULATION TO EXTEND
DEADLINES FOR NOTICE, OPT
OUTS AND MOTION FOR FINAL
APPROVAL OF CLASS ACTION
SETTLEMENT (ECF NO. 69)**

1 WHEREAS, on October 14, 2020, Plaintiff filed her original Class Action
2 Complaint, which she later amended (ECF No. 1 and 44).

3 WHEREAS, after multiple mediation sessions before an experienced mediator,
4 the parties reached a settlement that, subject to final approval, resolves Plaintiff's
5 claims and those of the class.

6 WHEREAS, on February 18, 2022, the parties filed a Motion for Preliminary
7 Approval of Class Action Settlement (ECF No. 64).

8 WHEREAS, the Motion for Preliminary Approval of Class Action Settlement
9 was granted on April 14, 2022 (ECF No. 68).

10 WHEREAS, the parties have worked diligently to proceed under the timeline
11 in the Court's order and to meet the deadlines set forth.

12 WHEREAS, the parties recently discovered a data issue where a particular
13 segment of the "known" class was excluded from receiving notice. The parties have
14 identified the issue and a remedy and intend to issue an identical notice to that
15 approved by the Court to that excluded group (the "Supplemental Notice") within 14
16 days of the entry of the Order on this Stipulation.

17 WHEREAS, those known class members who were inadvertently excluded
18 from the initial notice and will receive the Supplemental Notice are entitled to ninety
19 (90) days to exercise their rights to opt out of or object to the Settlement. That 90-
20 day window will exceed current deadlines approved by this Court. As a result, the
21 Parties request that those certain deadlines be extended as provided in the chart
22 below.

23 WHEREAS, the parties believe that no known or unknown class member will
24 be prejudiced by the requested extension of the applicable deadlines and the
25 extension will ensure that all known class members receive the Court-approved
26 notice.

1 WHEREAS, the parties request that the case deadlines be extended as follows,
 2 **subject to an amendment made by the Court to provide previously excluded**
 3 **known class members an opportunity to object or request exclusion before the**
 4 **final approval hearing:**

Event	Original Deadline	Updated Deadline
Last day for settlement administrator to mail the Supplemental Notice to previously excluded known class members	14 days from production of the class list	14 days from entry of the Order on this Stipulation
Last day for previously excluded known class members to submit requests for exclusion from or objections to the settlement	90 days from the date of mailing of the Notice	90 days from the date of the Supplemental Notice
Last day for Plaintiff to file motion for attorney fees, costs and class representative enhancement	28 days prior to the Final Approval Hearing	28 days prior to the Final Approval Hearing
Last day for Plaintiff to file a motion for final approval of the class action settlement	28 days prior to the Final Approval Hearing	28 days prior to the Final Approval Hearing
Final Approval Hearing	August 29, 2022 at 9 a.m.	October 17, 2022 <u>November 21, 2022,</u> at 9 a.m.

1 **GOOD CAUSE APPEARING, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:**

- 2 1. The case deadlines shall be extended as set forth above;
- 3 2. Plaintiff shall file a motion for final approval of the class action
- 4 settlement on or before ~~September 19, 2022~~ **October 24, 2022**; and
- 5 3. The hearing on the motion for final approval of the class action
- 6 settlement shall be set for ~~October 17, 2022~~ **November 21, 2022, at**
- 7 **9:00 a.m.**
